Play your part and support The FA's Code of Respect:

We **all** bear a collective responsibility to **set a good example** and help provide a **positive environment** in which children can learn and enjoy the game. **Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct** at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for **FUN**
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Respect the Referee's decisions even when you don't agree with them
- Appreciate good play from whatever team it comes from
- Remain behind the touchline and Respect Barrier
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition referee and match officials
- Support positively and offer players encouragement not criticism
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour

I understand if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken. I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
- Suspended or have my club membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependent.
